Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We Will Be Learning How To:

Celebrate our own achievements
Persist at something we find difficult
Understand what makes a good friend

You can help me at home by:

Talking about things I am good at and what I find difficult
Talk about my achievements both at home and school
Talk about what children could not do at the start of the year and what they can do now

Literacy & Communication and Language

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Read and understand simple sentences
- Demonstrate understanding when talking about what is read
- Write simple sentences that can be read by ourselves and others

You can help me at home by:

- Sharing stories with me every day.
- Ask questions about what has been read
- Encourage children to use their phonic skills to sound out words
- Ask children to write sentences and read back what they have written

Maths

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Double halve and share numbers
- Add 2 numbers together
- Write number sentences
- Subtract one amount from a larger amount below 10
- Use mathematical names to describe 3D shape

You can help me at home by:

- Using mathematical language to describe the properties of 3 D shape (A bean can is a cylinder etc)
- Use the language of doubling, halving and sharing in everyday situations (cutting a sandwich in half, sharing sweets equally)

Expressive Arts

We Will Be Learning How To:

- move and dance along to different types of instruments and music
- Experiment with musical dynamics including pace, volume timbre etc
- Safely explore a variety of materials tools and techniques
- Work collaboratively to act out a narrative

You can help me at home by:

- Encouraging me to be creative at home. Sing, dance, draw, paint, mould and engage in role-play with me
- Talk to me about my creations
- Find out what my favourite forms of creative expression are.
- Take me to museums and galleries

Physical Development

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Understand the importance of physical activity for good health
- Talk about healthy and unhealthy foods
- Practice appropriate safety measures
- Move confidently in a range of ways
- Negotiate space successfully
- Handle equipment and tools effectively
