You will have the chance to find out some of the services that your children might be accessing and contributing to online, now and in the future and be shown some practical ideas and website resources to help you to keep your family happy and safe online. This will help you to support us in our efforts to teach and encourage our pupils to make good choices when online.

The talk will not be “techy” and there will be an opportunity for you to ask any questions, either during the meeting or afterwards.

The workshop will be run by Mary Rebelo who is an Online Safety Ambassador for CEOP (Child Exploitation and Online Protection Agency) part of the Online Safety subcommittee for the safeguarding board of the London Borough of Camden, part of our LBDS (Grow) partnership and a Parentzone Digital Parenting Facilitator. She runs regular Online Safety workshops across the southeast for pupils, parents and teachers.

We would encourage as many parents as possible to attend the workshop as we know it will contain a lot of invaluable information on this important area. We are very keen for the message on Online Safety, from home and at school, to be as consistent as possible for all pupils.
