Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Say when we like some activities more than others Talk about their ideas say when they do or do not need help.
- Adjust and change their behaviour according to circumstances. Show sensitivity to others needs and feelings.

Literacy & Communication and Language

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Listen attentively in a range of contexts.
- Respond to stories with relevant questions, comments and actions.
- Answer how and why questions
- To blend and segment words
- To read words and simple sentences.
- To write short sentences in meaningful contexts

Maths

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number.
- Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
- They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
- Orders two or three items by length or height.
- Orders two items by weight or capacity.

Expressive Arts

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Build a repertoire of songs and dances
- Engage in imaginative role play
- Create own art work based on the work of Georgia O Keefe.
- Develop and act out a narrative.

Physical Development

We Will Be Learning How To:

- Show some understanding of how good practices with regard to eating, sleeping and hygiene can contribute to good health.
- Show an understanding of the need for safety when tacking new challenges.
- Consider and manage some risks
- Practice some appropriate safety measures without direct supervision

Understanding the World

- Talk about what a plant needs to grow
- Plant a range of seeds and plants and talk about how they grow and change over time
- Look closely at plants and flowers and comment on similarities and differences
- Discuss the changes of the seasons
- Learn about our world and how we can take care of it
