Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to welcome you and your child/children back from Monday 8th March 2021.

We will be following guidelines from the Government and social distancing measures will be in place. This is to ensure that your child/children, the staff and the wider school community stay safe. These will be reviewed regularly and updated in line with Government, and Local Authority advice.

As part of the guidelines from the Government, we will continue to implement staggered start and finish times for each year group.

All siblings will enter/exit the school together. Any Yr 3-6 children with siblings in the Infant school (Nur-Yr 2) will enter/exit via the Infant gate (Park Lane). If you and your sibling/s are in the Junior school, you will enter/exit the school via the gate in Worcester Avenue.

The rest of the Junior School children (Years 3-6), will enter and leave the school via the gate in Worcester Avenue. No Parents/Carers will be allowed on the school premises, unless you need to see someone as a matter of urgency.

You must be on time – children who are late, will have to wait until all other children have entered the building safely. You will then be directed to the school office to drop off your child.

School dinners will be provided as normal. If you provide your child/children with a packed lunch, please ensure that it is in a tight closing container. Please do not send packed lunches in plastic bags. Please provide a balanced and healthy packed lunch.

- Children will have their collective worship in their classrooms.
- Children will have break times and lunch times with their year group only.
- PE- on the days they have PE, the children will come to school wearing their PE kits (White T-shirt, black/navy blue leggings, jogging bottoms or shorts, plimsolls or black or white trainers). We will let you know on which days they have PE.
- We also ask that you make sure that PE kits are washed after use.
