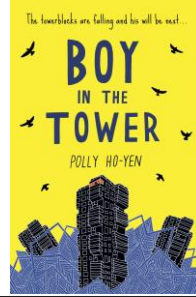

Reading

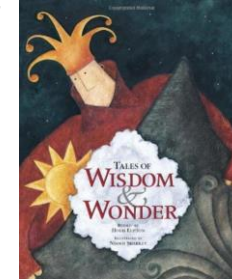
We will be using, 'Boy in the Tower', by Polly Ho Yen to develop our vocabulary and reading skills.
