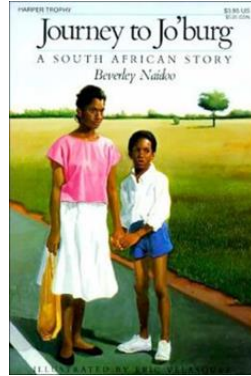

Home Learning

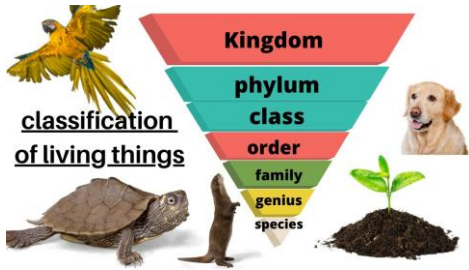
You can help at home by:
